2 Motivation Statement

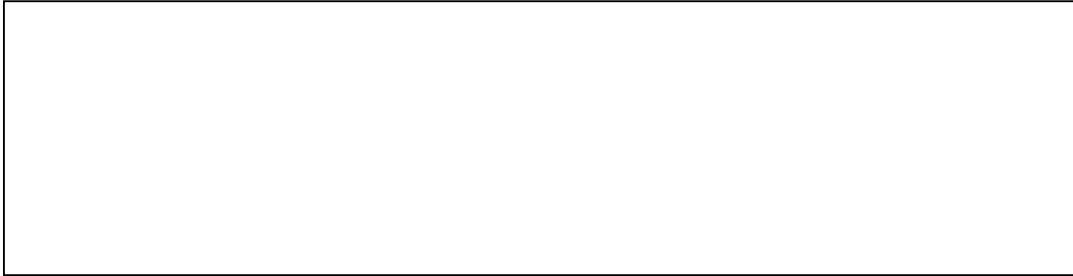
A written motivation statement of up to 500 - 800 words.

The statement must address the following questions:

- Why do you want to attend the programme?
- What is a current work-area issue you are facing?
- Why is it an issue?
- How do you plan to apply the knowledge and skills from the programme to address the issue?

3 Nomination Statement

A signed nomination statement indicating that you have approval from your employer and that you have their support to attend the Emerging Library Leaders' Summer School for Asia-Pacific (ELLSSA) in-person in Singapore between 8 – 12 July 2024.
